Jeff Morrissette talked about the CIRMA Public Act and the fact that each department is supposed to have a policy in place by July 1. The Fire Commission is working with the legal department to come up with a template to help the departments formulate their policy.

Pete Starkel, of the Smith Insurance Company, talked about a disability insurance policy and asked whether or not we wanted to sponsor a group policy. The Board of Directors will continue discussion on this and make a decision.

Reverend Venoit gave the benediction.
